Brazilian Verbena

Bonariensis

Light: Sun-partial shade

Water: Low-medium

Mature Size: 2-2 ½ H x 2 ft. W

Bloom Time: March-November

Bloom Color: Lavender, purple

Propagation: Herbaceous stem cuttings,
Seeds: direct sow outdoors in fall or after last frost

Plant Attributes: 🐝 🦋 (larval and nectar) 🦋



Care/Problems: Easy 'no care' plant that blooms for months without deadheading and does not require staking.

Comments: Works well as a midway plant because it can be seen over lower flowers in front of bed. Interesting to see swaying in the wind.
